Should you become elected to office, what efforts will you make to address the multimodal transportation challenges facing the growing cities, towns and regions in Tennessee?

I will continue to lead the efforts at the state level to fund, design, and build out the most comprehensive and forward-thinking transportation system available. I will again try to pass my legislation to form a joint study committee on the topic comprised of all relevant parties in order to study best practices, workable models around the world, and weigh various alternative design and funding plans.

How should the state support cities' efforts to build competitive transit systems?

The state should create and maintain a dedicated funding source for local governments to tap into to address their unique transit needs.

How will you work towards reducing roadway fatalities, including the increasing number of pedestrian fatalities, in our state?

I plan to build upon legislation that I authored and passed a few years back that protected bicycle lanes, making it illegal to operate motor vehicles in them.
